

LA SÉRIE QUÉBÉCOISE DE DÉVELOPPEMENT DES JEUNES HUNTERS 2024

PROGRAM'S DETAILS

Aspiring to help develop and value young horses toward the hunter discipline in Quebec, the program wishes to offer specific showing opportunities to green horses, ages 3 to 5 years old.

Horses will have to option to enter into the series as a division or into individual classes. Show results from the model and flat classes could be used to support a 3 years old horse's candidature application to the Lieutenant Governor and Governor General Cups at the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair, in Toronto in November.

Model : In hand presentation judged on conformation, temperament, movement and physical health. 50% conformation, 50% movement and health.

Flat : under saddle presentation at the walk, trot and canter in both directions judged on conformation, temperament, movement and health. 60% movement and health, 40% conformation.

Over fences: Over a 2'3" courses of maximum 8 jumps judged on style, temperament, movements and presentation. The horse show organiser may opt to hold a closed card schooling round along the o/f as practice for this final phase.

ELIGIBILITY

Registration (or proof of age)must be provided prior to entry. The "baby green" status of a horse will not be affected by a participation to the series. All riders and handlers must be current Equestrian Canada and Cheval Quebec members.

Ponies can enter into the model and flat phases only. An adult could ride a pony in the 3 years old, to qualify for a breed class at the Royal Winter Fair.

PRESENTATION :

A Grand Champion 4-5 years old will be crowned at each event, presented to the best of the three phases.

+ A **Grand Champion** by the *Canadian Sport Horse Association* will be presented, offered by the association, to a registered C.S.H horse best of the all phases.

+ A **Grand Champion CHEVAL ORIGINE QUÉBEC** will be presented, offered by Cheval Québec, to a registered C.O.Q horse best of all phases.

+ A **Grand Champion 3 years old** will be crowned at each event

OBJECTIVE 2024:

PROMOTE THE DEVELOPMENT OF 3-5 YEARS OLD HORSES IN THE HUNTER DISCIPLINE IN QUEBEC AND FACILITATE PRESENTATION AND QUALIFICATIONS OF 3 YEARS OLD

FINANCES:

45 % of incomes generated from the entry fees, collected by the show organisers, must be returned to the program to support the costs of prizes, ribbons and trophies handed out throughout the series' events.
